5. <u>Discussion and Action:</u> Regarding filing of the semi-annual report to monitor and evaluate the implementation of Impact Fees, the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), and Land Use Assumptions. (City Staff)

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Monitoring and filing of an annual report related to Impact Fees is a necessity. The Committee must meet at a minimum bi-annually to evaluate impact fees, the associated Capital Improvement Plan relating to Impact Fees, and the Lands Use Assumptions for the Impact Fee area as required by Chapter 395 TLGC.

The report consists of statements to make findings on the progress of the overall impact fees process, the Impact Fee Capital Improvement Plan, and the associated Land Use Assumptions.

The staff recommends an update to the Impact Fee ordinance in compliance with Chapter 395 TLGC.

**Regarding: Impact Fee Advisory Committee Semi-Annual Report** 

The purpose of this report is to provide City Council an update of the status of impact fees, Land Use Assumptions, and the Capital Improvements Plan as included in the Impact Fee Report, dated September 3, 2013.

The Impact Fee ordinance has been in place since September 3, 2013. Any building permit for new construction will trigger assessment and collection of impact fees. Due to the recent adoption of the Impact Fee and associated study, the volume of development within the September 2013 to February 2018 evaluation period is consistent with projected growth and development patterns.

At this time the Land Use Assumptions continue to be consistent with the adopted 2016 Comprehensive Plan Land Use Plan, and therefore no revisions are required at this time. The Capital Improvement Projects within the Impact Fee Ordinance that are connected to impact fees are commencing consistent with the approved plan. An update to the impact fees has commenced.

The Impact Fee Advisory Committee does not believe that any revisions to the Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvements Plan, or Impact Fees are warranted at this time.

#### **SYNOPSIS**

A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) has been sent out to a number of firms to provide the City with an updated impact fee study. An impact fee study and update must occur every five (5) years according to Section 395.052 of Chapter 395 in the TLGC. The last update occurred in 2013.

The current timeline is as follows:

- Questions due by: 5:00PM, Wednesday, February 14, 2018
- Proposal due by: 5:00PM, Wednesday, February 21, 2018
- Evaluation and selection, February/March
- Council contract award, March 6 or March 20, 2018

- Project Kick-off meeting with Impact Fee Committee, April 2018
- Project study, April June
  - Workshops or special meetings for project Schedule TBA
- Public Hearings July- August
- Goal Date of adoption, City Council August 21, 2018
